

**VILLAGE OF HOFFMAN ESTATES  
2016 PSEBA**

Public Safety Employee Benefits Act (820 ILCS 320/1 et seq.) or as it is more commonly known, “PSEBA”, provides eligible public safety employees and their eligible dependents free health care benefits. These benefits are available when the public safety employee “suffers a catastrophic injury or is killed in the line of duty” and “the injury or death must have occurred as the result of the officer’s response to fresh pursuit, the officer or firefighter’s response to what is reasonably believed to be an emergency, an unlawful act perpetrated by another, or during the investigation of a criminal act.”

The annual costs to be paid by the Village per PSEBA listed below are effective through 12/31/2016.
