

**VILLAGE OF HOFFMAN ESTATES
2011 PSEBA**

Public Safety Employee Benefits Act (820 ILCS 320/1 et seq.) or as it is more commonly known “PSEBA” is a relatively new law in Illinois that provides for the long-term health care benefits for public safety employees and certain of their dependents. These benefits are available when the covered public safety employee “suffers a catastrophic injury or is killed in the line of duty” and “the injury or death must have occurred as the result of the officer’s response to fresh pursuit, the officer or firefighter’s response to what is reasonably believed to be an emergency, an unlawful act perpetrated by another, or during the investigation of a criminal act.”
